

EXTRA CODE 9'S

I. **PURPOSE:** To define a policy for non-patrol members who wish to perform extra Code 9's, which is primarily done during the summer months.

II. GENERAL

A. An S.A.V. member who is a hard badge member but is not actively involved with patrol activities may sign up to do Extra Code 9's during the months of May, June, July, August and September.

B. The scheduling personnel will post an Extra Code 9s sign up calendar on the board by the normal patrol schedule.

C. Since this unit goes out as a patrol and is available for utilization at any incident as patrol unit, there must be a Car Commander and partner for the Extra Code 9s patrol. S.A.V. 10-100s may go alone.

D. Non-patrol members performing Extra Code 9s must pass the Nifty Fifty Code test and have refresher training on radio operation, conducted by FOD, before signing up for Extra Code 9s.

E. The normal Code 9 Procedures, as listed in the FOD Policy and Procedure Manual, will be followed.

F. If the partner is a non-patrol member and the unit is called by COMM or the PCSD 10-100 to assist at an incident, only the Car Commander is authorized to perform Traffic Control.

G. The Car Commander will call COMM and indicate they are going out as Golf 17, Special Assignment, Code 9s, normal Code 20s.
