

RETURNING MEMBERS

I. **PURPOSE:** To define a policy for members to return to S.A.V who have retired/resigned or are current members who want to return to patrol duties.

II. **GENERAL:** Each returning member will be evaluated on their prior record to determine their suitability to perform assigned duties. The Commander, Deputy Commanders and the Division Director of the Division where the returning member wants to work will determine the suitability of the member to return. Any returning member must be approved by the PCSD, with a background check completed if the member has been gone for more than one (1) year).

III. **TRAINING:** Based upon the above evaluation, the returning member will be required to undergo additional training as determined by the S.A.V. Commander. Members returning to vehicle patrol must obtain the following qualifications:

- A. Defensive Driving training.
- B. NIMS training.
- C. CPR Training.
- D. Pass the Nifty Fifty radio code test.
- E. Computer Report writing. This can be done during OJT training.
- F. Satisfactory completion of four to eight OJT rides with experienced Car Commanders, as determined by the S.A.V. Commander.

IV. **PROBATION:** The returning member is considered to be on probation until all training requirements are completed.
