

MEMBER UTILIZATION

I. **PURPOSE:** To define the utilization of S.A.V. members, particularly those who no longer perform vehicle patrol.

II. **GENERAL:** S.A.V. Members will be utilized to fullest extent possible, based on their skills, abilities and willingness to volunteer.

III. **UTILIZATION:** All S.A.V. members may participate in any recognized S.A.V. event or activity, **except:**

a. Vehicle Patrol members must be assigned to and scheduled by the Field Operations Division.

b. Traffic Control on public streets must be done by members assigned to the Field Operations Division.

IV. **WHITE ELEPHANT PATROL:** Soft Badge members or Hard Badge members who no longer perform vehicle patrol may perform White Elephant patrol alone, after the White Elephant Patrol Manager is satisfied that the person has sufficient knowledge and skill to patrol alone. Until such time, the individual must patrol with a fully qualified S.A.V. member. Radio UIDs will be given to the S.A.V. 10-100.

IV. **MALL PATROL:** Soft Badge members and Hard Badge members who no longer perform vehicle patrol may patrol with another S.A.V. member (Soft or Hard Badge) under the following rules:

a. A Hard Badge and a Soft Badge may use one patrol car for transportation, as needed. The S.A.V. 10-100 will be consulted about which patrol vehicle to utilize.

b. Two Soft Badge mall patrol members must use the golf cart or their own vehicle, as desired. A patrol car will not be utilized in this case. Radio UIDs will be given to the S.A.V. 10-

100. The Mall Patrol Manager will conduct any training required to insure that the Soft Badge members understands all aspects of Mall Patrol.

IV. SPECIAL EVENTS: Soft Badge members, and Hard Badge Members who are no longer performing vehicle patrol, may be utilized provided they will not conduct any traffic control on a public street. They may be utilized on a private street or a private parking lot i.e., GVR Centers, HOA streets, etc.
